Estate Agent Fees

When we instruct your property we will ask you to sign a contract, our fees are 5%* of the sale price plus 7% I.G.I.C.. We do not charge you to market your property, the fee is to be paid at point of sale.

At the valuation we will go through everything in detail but in the meantime here is a little guide to what is needed to sell your property:

Energy Certificate

An energy rating certificate must be obtained by Spanish law at the point of marketing your property.

The certificate is obtained by an architect and we can organize this for you. The average cost is 100€ for an apartment and 160€ for a villa.

Electric Certificate (CAI)

If the property is over 20 years then it needs to be brought up to EU standard and an electric certificate needs to be obtained to pass inspection. We can recommend an electrician to give you a quote and can oversee the work if any is needed to be carried out.
